

TRIPLETTZ

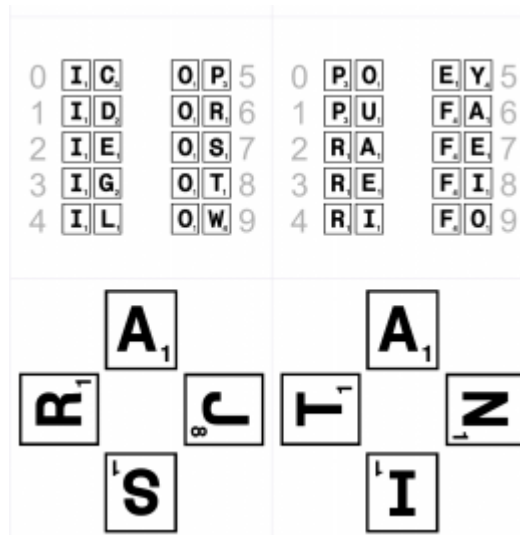
TripLettz is a simple word building game where players simultaneously make three-letter words (with an option for 4+ letters). For ages 6+.

COMPONENTS

- 15 bigram cards
- 25 letter cards
- D10 die
- Optional dry erase scoreboards

GOAL:

Score the highest points by making the best words.



SETUP:

1. Shuffle and place the bigram cards face down between the players.
2. Shuffle the letter cards and give each player two cards. Place the remaining cards face down in a draw pile.
3. If available, give each player a scoreboard and dry erase marker. Otherwise, nominate a score keeper.
4. Decide if unscrambling of letters is allowed – this allows words of up to six letters to be formed.

GAME PLAY:

Game play is simultaneous. A player flips over a bigram card and rolls the D10 die. The number on the die matches a number on the bigram card to select the bigram that all players will use simultaneously.

Each player calls out one word made by combining one or more of the letters on one of their letter cards with that of the selected bigram. The word is scored.

The bigram card is replaced with a new bigram card.

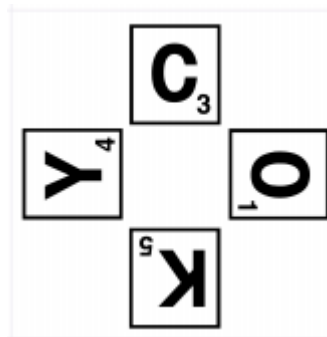
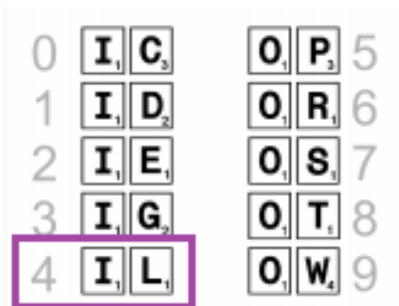
Upon scoring their word, each player may elect to replace their letter card with another card.

FORMING A WORD:

A word is formed by combining one letter from a letter card with that of the bigram selected on the bigram card.

The letter can be added to the start or end of the bigram. If unscrambling is allowed, the word can be a combination all letters in any order that makes a valid word.

Examples:



ILK: 7 points

OIL: 3 points

If **unscrambling** is allowed, players can use up to 6 letters to form a word!

YOLK: 11 LICK: 10

LOCK: 10 ICKY: 10

KILO: 9 KOI: 7

OILY: 7 COIL: 6

WINNING:

After all bigram cards have been played, the person with the highest scores will be the winner. In case of a tie, play another round.
