SCRABBLE® BATTLE

Control the Battlefield with Words.

In this wordy battle, your goal is to be first to claim the control zone (blank middle row) with four completed words.

Lay your set of Scrabble® tiles face down as your shared "arsenal". Select either the 4x7 or 5x7 "battlefield" and face your opponent. Draw and maintain four tiles.

Take turns placing tiles in an attempt to complete a word vertically within your column from bottom to top. The first (bottommost) letter starts your word.

Build words that have enough letters to cross into the control zone. You may place your tile in any cell on your end.

You cannot cross past the control zone; do not make longer words.
You may move one of your tiles instead of placing a new tile.
You may swap any two tiles, on or off the grid.

You may place a tile into the control zone once the column has a complete word.

The first letter need not be covered, however your column will not be locked.


You may place a matching tile on the bottommost cell in order to lock your column. Locking prevents stealing by your opponent.

You may stack your identical letter in the control area on top of your opponent's tie, if the opponent has not locked their column.

To win, complete at least four words that end in the control zone and have at least one locked column.

The first letter need not be covered with a tile. However, that unlocked column can be stolen by your opponent.

To lock a column, cover the first (bottommost) letter with a Scrabble tile.
