## OVERVIEW

One or more players use your own Scrabble® tiles to discover multiple hidden words.

## SIMULTANEOUS GAME PLAY

Print one of the pages above per player. Flip all your Scrabble® tiles face down.

All players play at the same time and have one minute per round.

You will play six rounds to determine a winner and end up with 21 tiles.

In the first round, each player grabs six tiles.

In the second round, each player grabs five tiles.

In subsequent rounds, grab one less tile, and so on.

In the final round, each player grabs one tile and has five minutes to finish.


Each row contains at least two secret words to discover.

Each cell has six letters to choose from.

Place each letter on a cell containing a matching letter.

Strategically place and/or rearrange tiles to collect letters into words.

Examine the letters and choose the best to formulate a word.



Note that you will probably end up moving letters around between rows to maximize your score.

## SCORING

At the end of five rounds, score the values of your completed words. Each row has a score multiplier to increase your score. However, for fairness, the highest letter value will be 5 points (JQXZ). Highest score wins. Tie breaker: highest valued letters.
