GOAL

Two or more players compete to make and collect words.

SET UP

Print the game board above.

Flip all 98 Scrabble® letter tiles face down between the players.

RULES

Playing in turns, each player rolls both dice and selects an empty space.

The selected row or column will match one of the die rolls.

Take a tile and strategically place it on the selected space.

As more and more tiles are place,
look carefully for ways to make words from adjacent letters.

Call out the word(s) made, grab the tiles and
place them face down in front of you to score later.

Words can be made in any of eight directions:
up or down, diagonally, backwards and forwards.

The minimum word length is three letters.

However, the youngest children can form two-letter words.

It is possible to form more than one word simultaneously from a strategically-
placed letter.

Once all the tiles have been played, each player counts
the value of their collected letters to determine the winner.
In case of a tie, whoever has the highest valued tile(s) is the winner.

In this example, "TOW" is ready to be collected.
