OVERVIEW

Use your own Scrabble® tiles to scratch off letters on your game sheet. Print one game sheet per player. Everyone needs a pen or pencil. Place all your Scrabble tiles face down between the players. Pick a target score between 50 and 100.

GAME PLAY

Take turns flipping over one tile at a time. On your page, pick any word and scratch off all the letters matching the letter revealed. Once a word is completed, circle its score.

If you draw a blank tile, call out any letter for all to use.

Repeat until a winner is declared.
Expect about 15-20 minutes play time.

WINNING

The winner will be the first player whose completed words total or exceed the target score.

TIP

Insert the game pages between dry erase sheets and use dry erase markers.

DICE OPTION

When selecting a tile, roll a single die. This will indicate how many words to pick for scratching off the letter.
