OVERVIEW

This is a multi-player game where you use Scrabble® tiles to make the most valuable words. The words are unscrambled from selected and collected letters.

INSTRUCTIONS

Print one of the bigram pages above for each player. Flip an entire set of your own Scrabble® tiles face down as the draw pile.

GAME PLAY

Playing simultaneously, all players grab two random tiles each. Select a location on your grid and call out a word that is a combination of at least three letters. The word is unscrambled from three or four letters.

For example: **TS** plus **A** and **M** can form **MAST**,
while **EN** plus **W** will form **NEW**.

Stack the letter(s) at the grid location.

If you cannot unscramble a word, return the tiles and end your turn.

WINNING

The game ends when all players can no longer form a new word.

For fairness, the maximum individual tile value is 5 points.

This means that J,Q,X and Z are worth 5 points each.

Add up the points of all your tiles plus the number of tiles.

The player with the highest score wins.

In this example, "**L**" and "**K**" are stacked onto "**CA**" to call out "**LACK**";
