## Control the Battlefield with Words.

You and your opponent face each other with your own set of Scrabble® tiles laid upside down between you. Draw and maintain three tiles.

Your goal is to be first to control the blank middle row (control zone) with three tiles.

Take turns placing tiles in an attempt to make words vertically within your five columns from bottom to top.

Build words that have at least six letters to cross into the control zone.

You cannot cross past the control zone.

You may move one of your tiles instead of placing a new tile.

To win, complete at least three six-letter words that end in the control zone.

The first letter need not be covered with a tile.

However, for a more challenging game, a completed word must cover its bottommost starting letter.
