

SCRABBLE® SQUARES FIVE

Maintain one tile in secret.

SCRABBLE® SQUARES SIX

Maintain two tiles in secret.

SCRABBLE® SQUARES SEVEN

Maintain three tiles in secret.

GOAL

Two or more players compete to make and collect words.

SET UP

Print one of the game boards above.

Flip all 98 Scrabble letter tiles face down between the players.

RULES

Playing in turns, each player strategically takes a tile and places it on an empty space. You will be laying tiles in order to make words from adjacent letters. Look carefully.

Call out the word(s) made, grab the tiles and place them face down in front of you to score later.

Words can be made in any of eight directions:
up or down, diagonally, backwards and forwards.

The minimum word length is three letters.
However, the youngest player(s) can form two-letter words.
It is possible to form more than one word simultaneously.

Once all the tiles have been played, each player counts the value of their collected letters to determine the winner.
In case of a tie, whoever has the highest valued tile(s) is the winner.

Adding "D" yields "DUG" and "DEN".
