## Instructions


Each horizontal grid line holds just one word. Letters already in the grid are unique. Missing letters are above the grid. Patterns are presented in boxes below the grid.

Using these patterns, drag a missing letter from the top of the puzzle into the grid.

If the pattern includes dots or bars, the letters are somewhere in the row (...) or column (bars) but **NOT ADJACENT**.

If the clue is a pair of letters (eg **SE TR ZI**), they must be placed

**ADJACENT** in the grid (up or down as indicated).  
If you have placed wrongly, tap the letter to return it.



XI means both letters will be found together (adjacent)  
 I means I is above the R;  
 ? ? means the letters are R NOT ADJACENT  
 R can only go in one of the indicated spots.  
 Because of ?, the R cannot be immediately below I.  
 I can only be adjacent to the X.  
 ? means letter is on same line or row but more than one space apart.
